Our IST192 class will be taking all of our tests, submitting all assignments, and uploading lab assignments to <https://moodle.beausanders.org>. Your login ID will be the same in IST190 and IST191, i.e. **lastnamefirstname14** (all lower case).

Your password on <https://moodle.beausanders.org> should be the same as when you took IST191. If it does not work, please click on this link and follow the instructions: https://moodle.beausanders.org/moodle/login/forgot_password.php.

We will continue using the **VMware Virtual Lab** for our Lab Assignments. Your instructor will create an **empty 64-bit virtual server** for your use in IST192.

You will continue to access **the VMware Virtual Lab** using the **VMware View Client** we used in IST191. If necessary, you can download the VMware View Client at <http://view.qvltec.edu>. Your username is your **Blackboard username** and your temporary password is **Password01** which you will be prompted to reset on your next log in. Instructions for the VMware Virtual Lab are available at <https://beausanders.org/IST192> in the menu.

When downloading files from the beausanders.org servers, you will be asked for a username and password. Since most of the download materials are copyrighted, you will be asked to enter the following username and password to access the files:

Username = **ist192**
Password = **squid**
